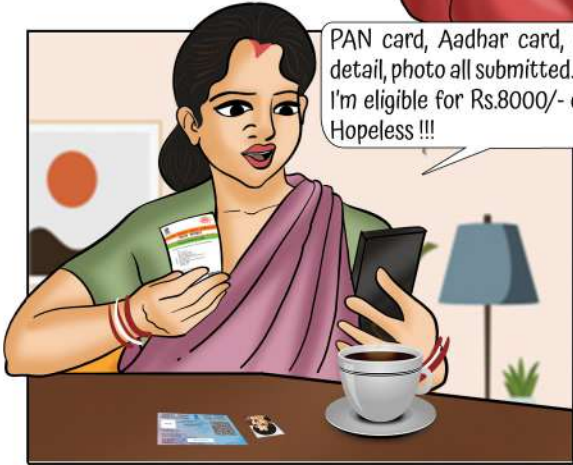
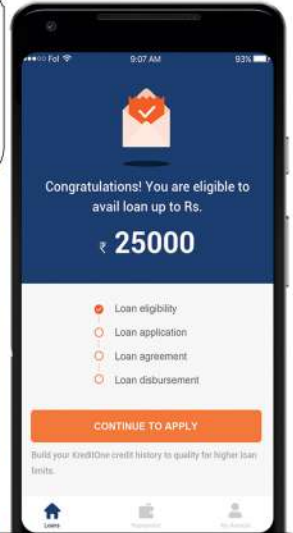

Whosoever has downloaded our Loan App, transfer Rs.3800/- to their accounts. After 3 days, start forcing for repayment. You must extract Rs.25000/- from each of them.

Your relative is not repaying our loan. Your name is mentioned as guarantor. So you have to pay Rs.25000/- now.

Hello! who is this?

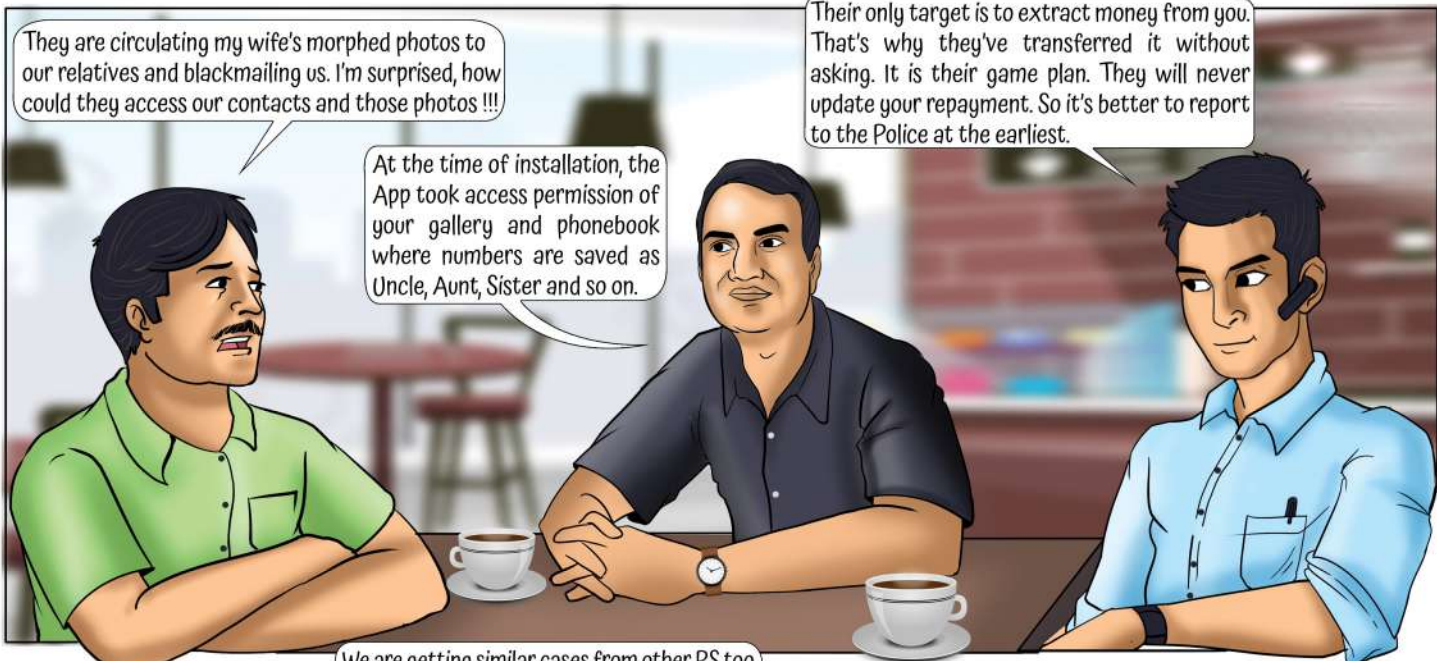


Loan App Company called my Uncle. Abused him very badly. Now he is very annoyed!

They sent me a message. If you don't pay the money within 1 day, they will pass on your obscene photos to all your contacts.

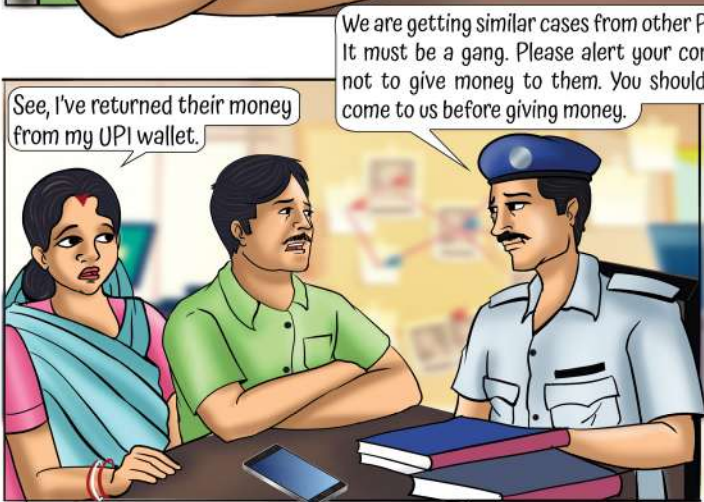
Oh No!!!

Their only target is to extract money from you. That's why they've transferred it without asking. It is their game plan. They will never update your repayment. So it's better to report to the Police at the earliest.



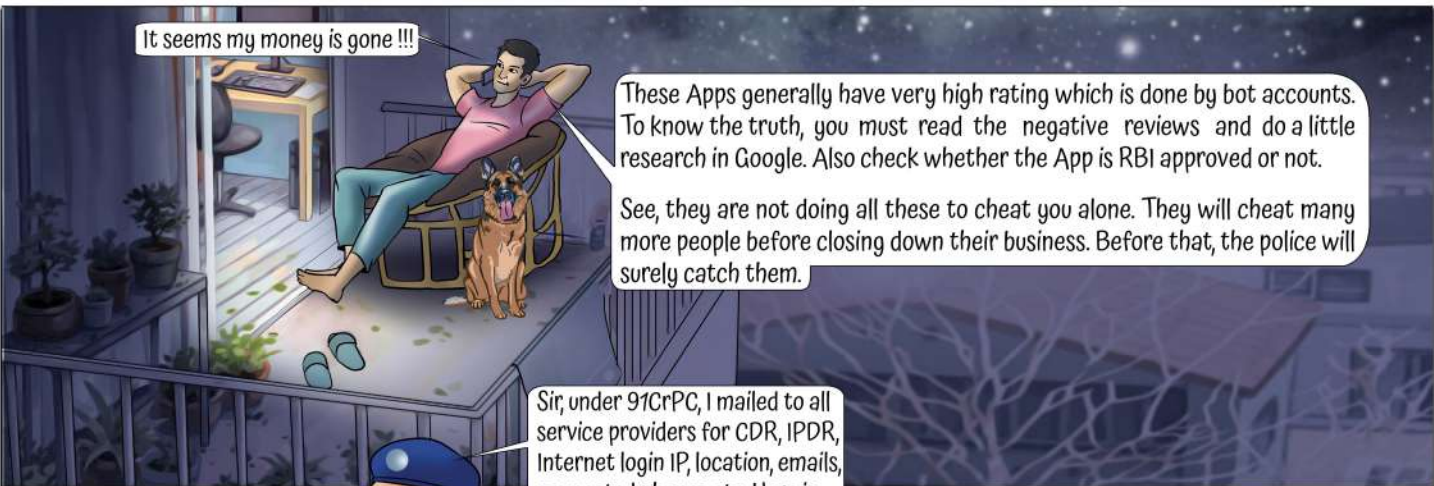
See, I've returned their money from my UPI wallet.

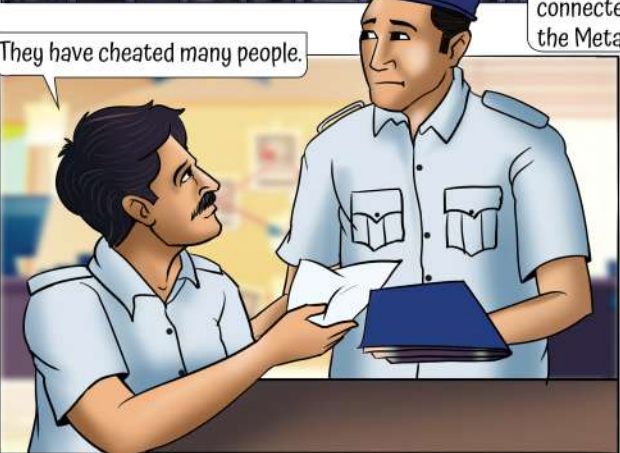

See, they are not doing all these to cheat you alone. They will cheat many more people before closing down their business. Before that, the police will surely catch them.

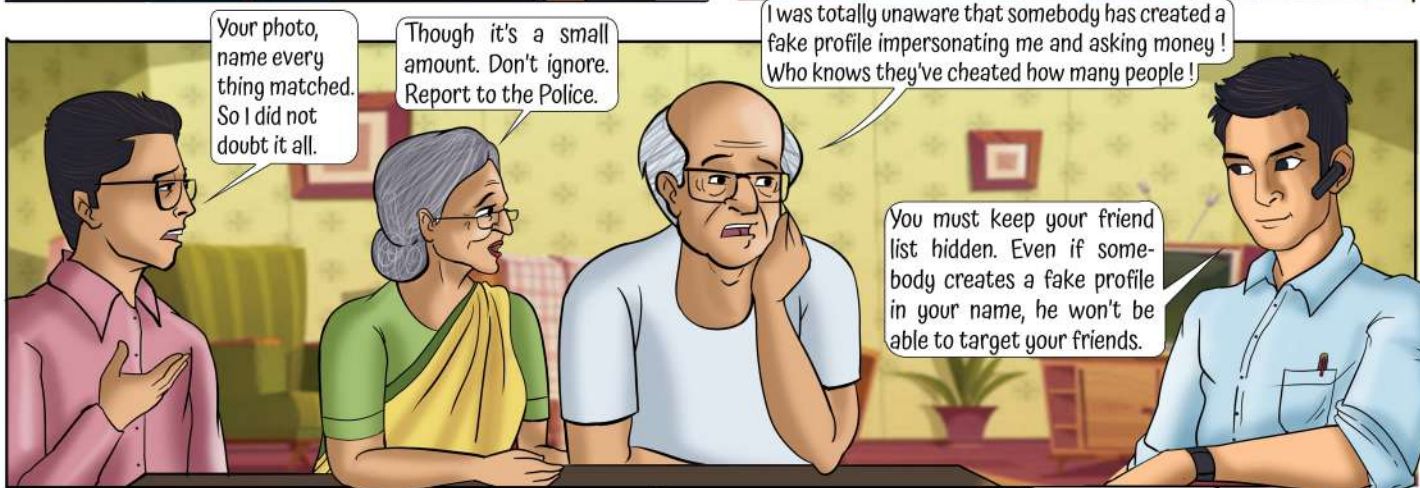
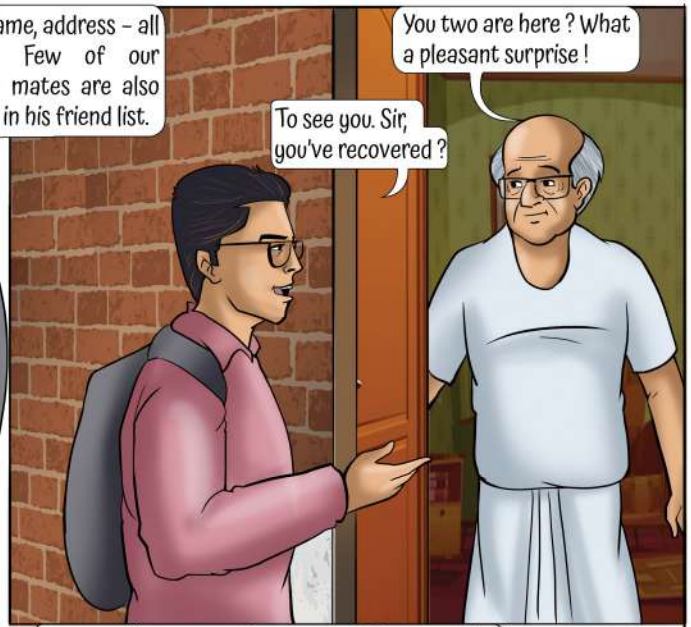
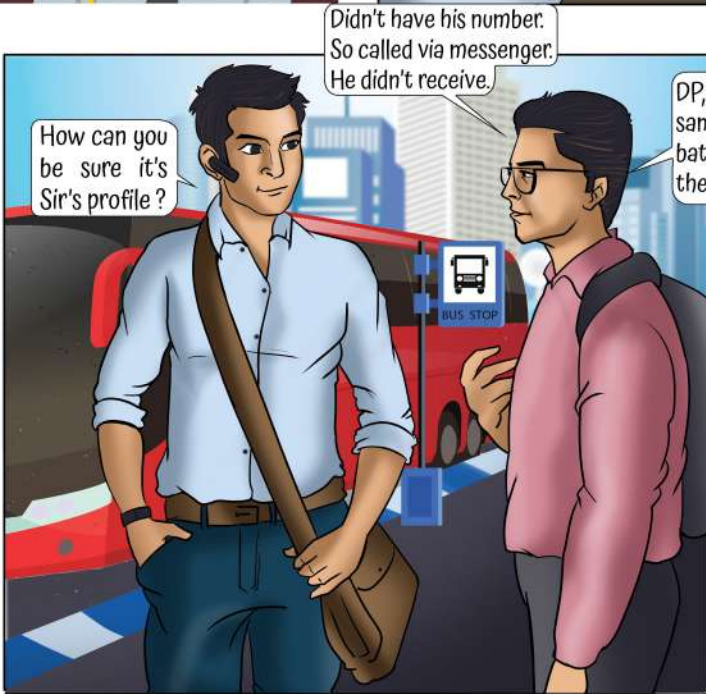
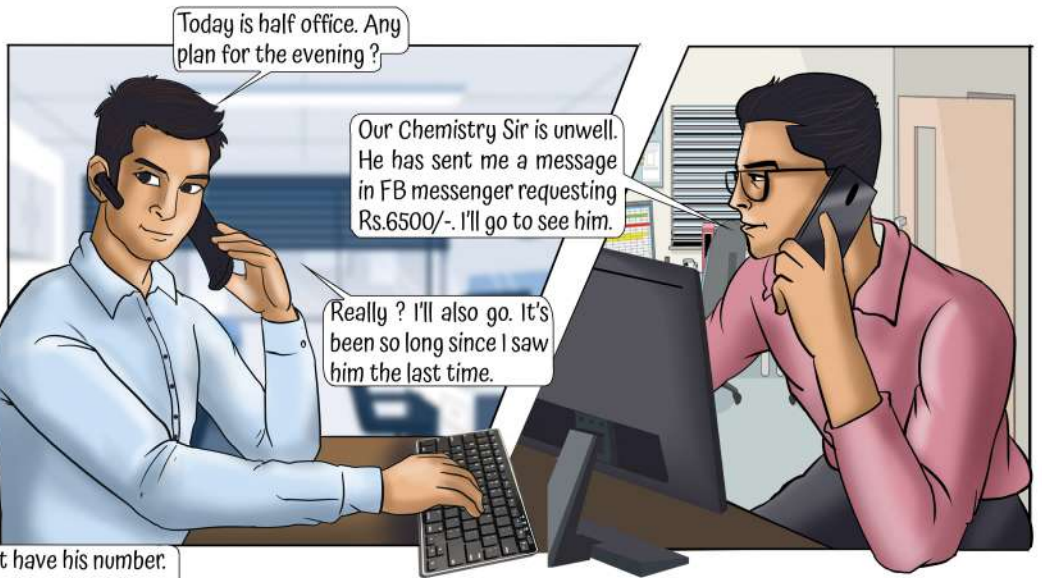

And whatever you search in Google, it start showing related advertisements. You've searched for JOB, and so all JOB related ads were shown to you.

Don't pay a single penny. Just report to the police.



### SECURITY TIPS FOR ONLINE JOBS

- o Enquire thoroughly about the employer.
- o Paying huge money for a very simple job should be a scam.
- o If the employer gives you work without verifying your qualifications, work experience, then possibly it is a scam.
- o There is no method of measuring the percentage of errors in a typing job.
- o At the beginning, there must be a written agreement where all the terms and conditions are clearly stated. They can employ you only if you agree to all the conditions.
- o No one can charge a penalty on the pretext of errors in work.

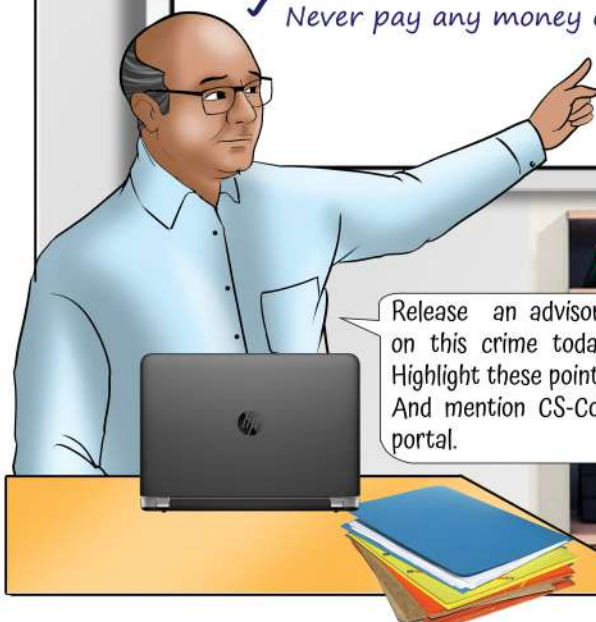

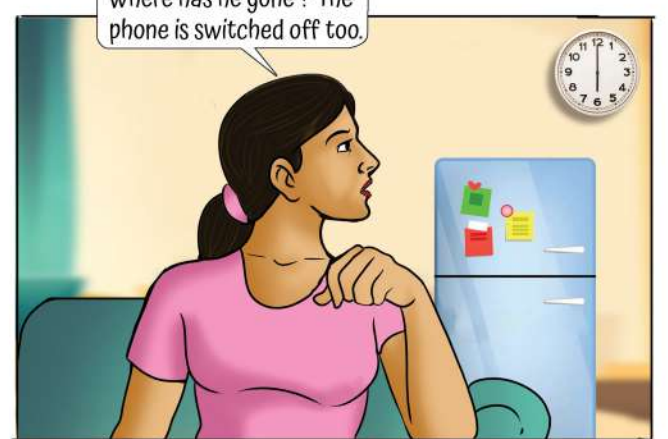
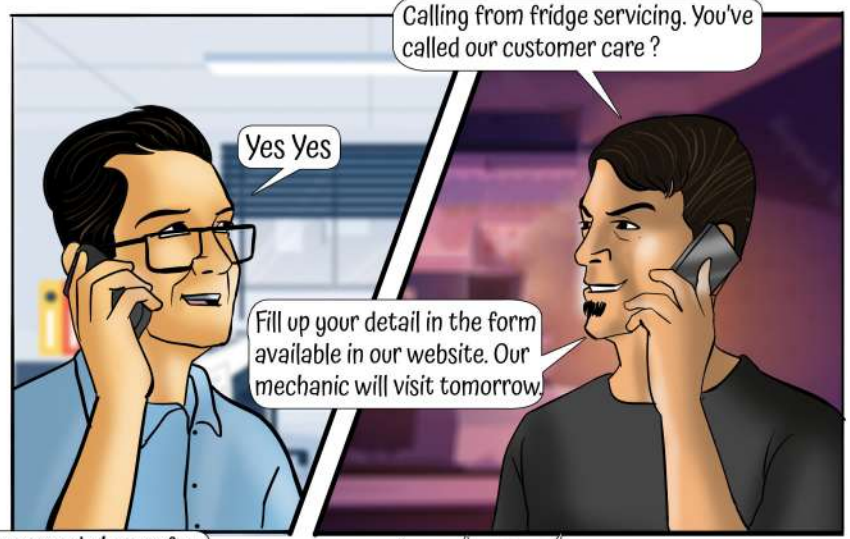


We, the aged people, are not so tech-savvy and trust everyone easily.

Tomorrow there is a call. Let it continue like this.

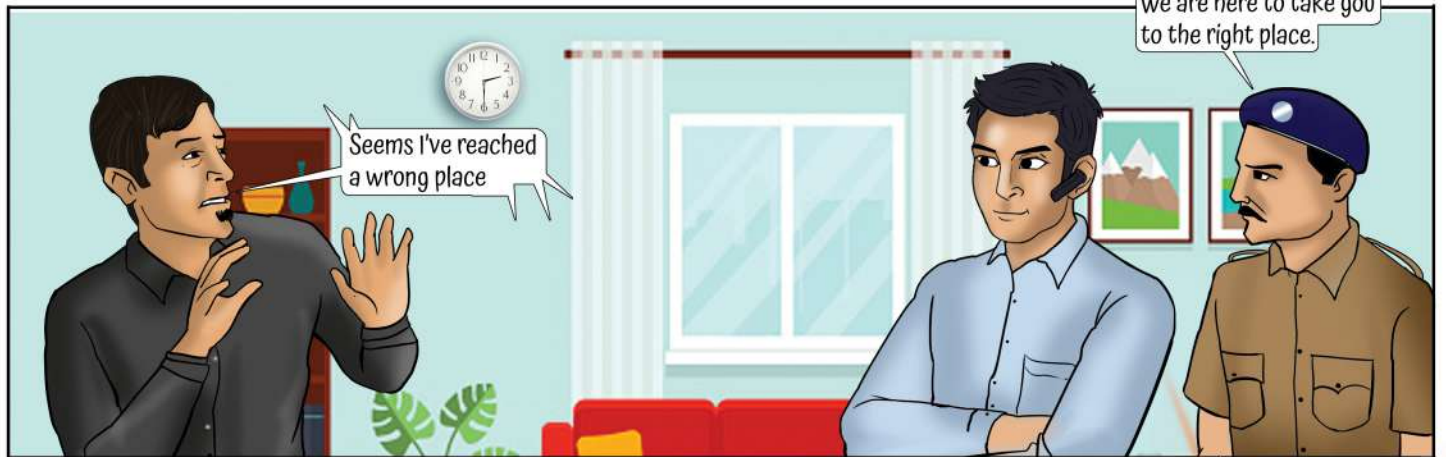
However, it was not a very big amount. But how can I accept this loss ?

Tomorrow we will go to your office to conduct OJT (On Job Training) and explain the security tips in detail. Look, to know about something, we Google it first and consider the topmost result as the correct one. But any website can be brought to the top by search engine optimization. This is how criminals bring their fake websites at the top and we fall into their traps while buying some goods or services. The scope of cybercrime is not limited to the cyber world only. A small mistake made there, can bring the culprit to your home.

People avoid legal hassles for small amount. Incidents remain unreported and so culprits are not caught. The criminals enjoy benefits from your mind-set. Tomorrow you'll go to the police station first. These people must be caught. Send me the website link and the culprit's phone number.

I checked with DNS lookup, didn't get much details of the website owner. But many have written on several feedback sites that it is a fake site and they have also been cheated. From them we can find out culprit's appearance, talking styles, behaviours etc. I mean you can profile the culprit.

I'll do that. We have to pay them back in their own coin. The website is still operational. You book a service call from your address.



### ON THE JOB TRAINING (CS-CoE)

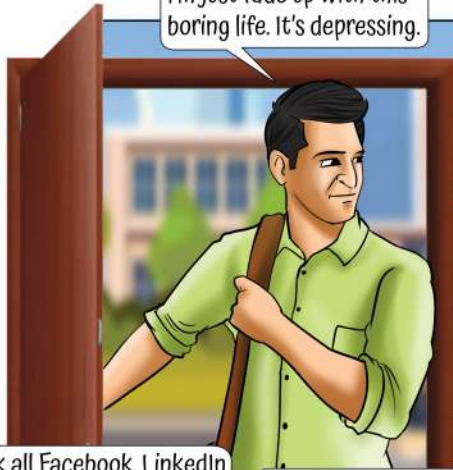
- Original websites come with the company name and correct spelling. Watch carefully.
- Fake websites are usually created on free domains like <https://about.me/>; <https://www.jdomni.com/>; <https://taplink.at/en/> etc. Notice the domain.
- If the word 'Ad' is written next to the search result, it means that it is an advertisement and it has been brought up by search engine optimization by paying Search Engines. Avoid them.
- There are some websites where you can check any website owner's name, address, who has registered, related email, location etc. These are: <https://www.whois.com/whois/>; <https://hostingchecker.com/>; <https://webhostingdetector.com/> etc. Verify properly.
- Do not fill any form in any website unless you are sure that the website is genuine.





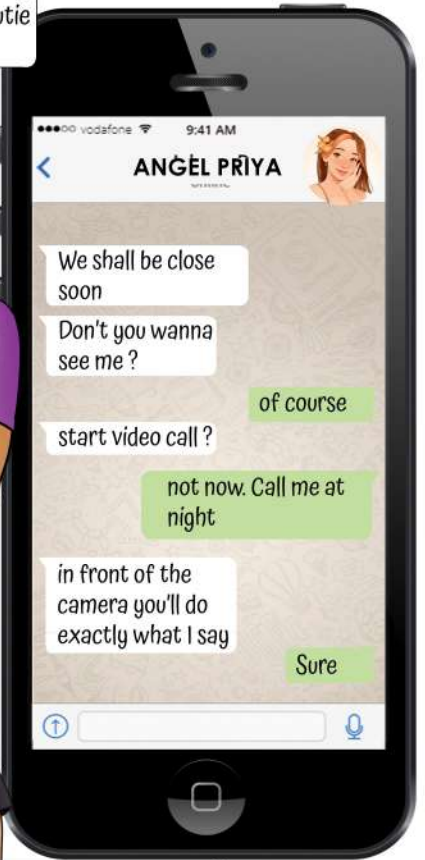

This is the payment confirmation receipt. We are in deep trouble at this unknown place.



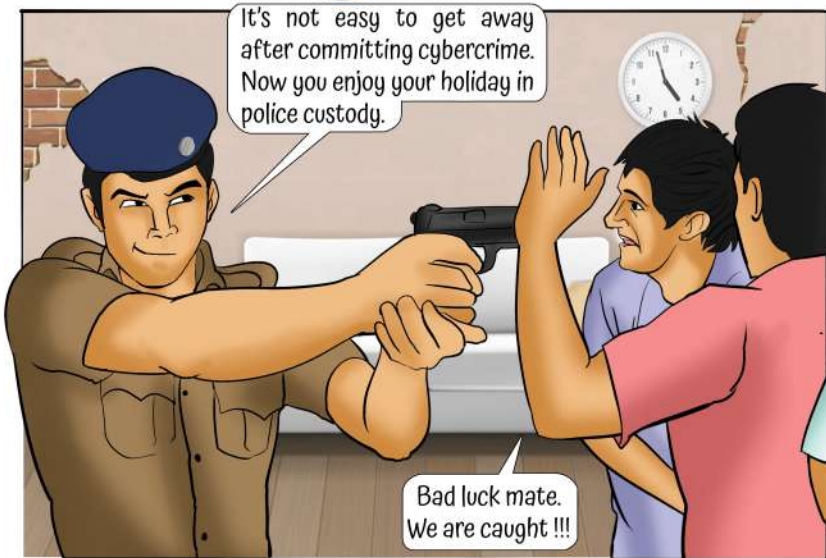

Cannot sell the Bitcoins? Ok, I'll come in the evening and do it.

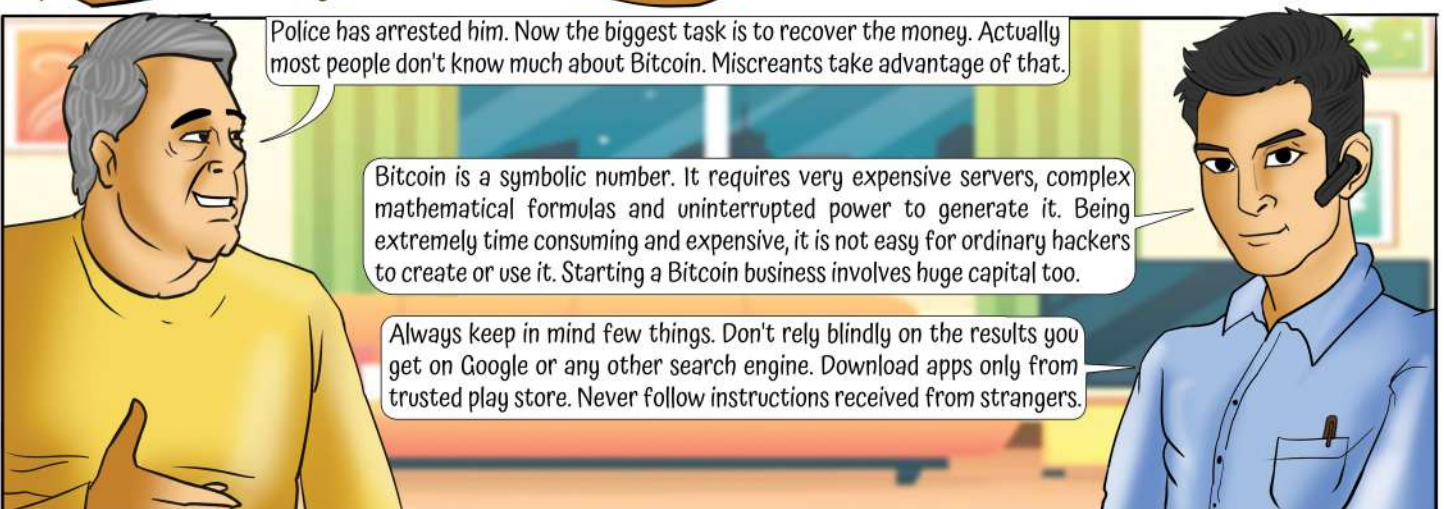


I've also tried in every possible way but with no result. I'm taking the phone for analysing the App.



It's a dummy App with similar look and feel of Bitcoin wallet. I must inform the police.

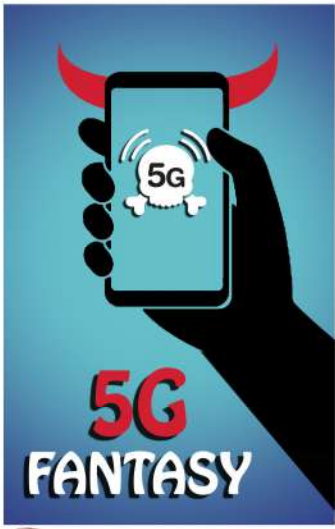

# 4 senior citizens conned out of ₹4L

On August 17, said an officer. Krishnakali Ghosh, HA Block, too, lost Rs 50,000 in a similar fraud. They received an SMS, asking to contact an electricity official. "I was sent and we gave the link. Within 10 minutes, I lost Rs 50,000," she said.

Anubrata Roy, an executive living in Salt Lake, lost Rs 30,000. He received a completion certificate from a retired school teacher. "I was conned out of Rs 55,000. The fraudster claimed to be an official of the electricity department..."

# Cryptocurrency fraud cuffs on six

"The raid is part of an extensive drive against fake call centres following an order by Bidhannagar commissioner, Gaurav Sharma," said an officer.

A senior officer said that the group had converted millions of dollars into cryptocurrency through the siphoning of funds from various sources.

# Sextortion FIRs doubled in 2022 but no major spurt seen in cybercrimes

## AWARENESS DRIVES ON, SAY POLICE

- ▶ 22 sextortion cases were reported last year making it one of the highest heads of cybercrimes in the city
- ▶ This is around 10% of all cybercrimes reported in Kolkata
- ▶ 172 cases were reported in 2020 and it was a massive increase from the 160 recorded in 2019 in the pre-Covid year
- ▶ There has been a sharp decline in cases getting reported since the start of the year



Overall, Kolkata Police recorded 212 FIRs in cybercrimes in 2022. The number of sextortion cases has doubled in 2022 compared to 2021.

There has been a sharp decline, too, in cases getting reported over phone, email and FIR. "We had received such complaints..."
